One of the world's noble grape varieties. It has the smallest bunches and berries of all white varieties, thereby imparting immense flavour and concentration to the resultant wines. Added to this, is the distinction that few other white varieties are able to mature to their betterment, for decades, like the best global examples of Riesling are able to.

TASTING NOTE

Intense orange blossom, lanolin, citrusy notes, also honeyed and hints of yellow straw on the bouquet. Super fresh on entry, lemon, lime cordial flavours intermingled with chalky flavours. The palate expresses in a linear fashion, with wonderful definition.

Vegan fried rice; sushi; grilled salmon with fresh ginger; coq au Riesling.
