Spicy, cloves, perfumed violets, Karoo shrub, white pepper all lurking and poised. Intense, yet showing a silky, velvety feel. Beautiful elegance balances uber fine-grained, dry, polished tannins.

Biltong, rare roast beef with pepper sauce, nutty cheddar. Beef short rib on the barbecue.

Barrel Ageing 19 months in 30% new French oak, balance in 2nd and 3rd fill French oak barrels
